GRANT APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Organization Requirements

- IRS 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, for at least 12 months.
- Rated on Charity Navigator or GuideStar.
- Program site is located within 25 miles of a USA Panera Bread bakery-cafe.

Organization's Beneficiary

- Program supports underserved or at-risk children and youth (ages 10-18).
- Population served is predominately those who are historically underrepresented in our communities, including Black, Latinx, and Indigenous peoples.

Program Requirements

- New, existing or expanding a program to support children and youth in becoming our future leaders.
- Supported programs: Skills building, leadership and workforce development, post-secondary planning, mentorship, college readiness.

Organizations NOT Supported

- Schools, religious organizations, other 501(c)(x) organizations. Political organizations, lobbying or campaigns. Municipalities. Individuals. Events. Food or product donations.
- Organizations practicing unlawful or discriminatory practices.
